Please be advised immediately due to a shortage of the rabies vaccine Imrab3, The Columbia County Health Department has had to purchase another rabies vaccine from a different vendor. This different vaccine that the Health Department will be using at the remaining clinics is just for cats and dogs and NOT registered for ferrets. For the remaining rabies clinics in 2010, the Columbia County Health Department will be vaccinating dogs and cats only.

Until further notice, Columbia County residents will need to contact their own vet to have their ferrets vaccinated for rabies. The Health Department would like to thank the residents for their cooperation.
