Both vaccines are free and no appointment is necessary. There will be no out-of-pocket expense and it would be appreciated for those individuals who may have Medicare Part-B, Blue Shield of Northeast NY, Today's Options, or Senior Whole Health to bring their insurance cards as we will be able to bill insurance/Medicare for the administration fee to help cover our costs.
