### **Notice of Public Hearing**

#### **Columbia County, New York**

The Columbia County Board of Supervisors will hold a public hearing on Wednesday, September 8 at 7:30 PM at 401 State Street Office Building Hudson, NY 12534 in the Board Chamber for the purpose of hearing public comments on the Columbia County's community development needs and to discuss the submission of a Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) application under the CDBG-CV (CARES Act) program for the 2021 program year. This particular funding round is restricted to projects that directly respond to COVID 19. The CDBG program is administered by the New York State Office of Community Renewal (OCR), and will make available to eligible local governments approximately \$60 million for housing, economic development, public facilities, public infrastructure, and planning activities, with the principal purpose of benefitting low/moderate income persons. The hearing will provide further information about the CDBG program and will allow for citizen participation in the development of any proposed grant applications and/or to provide technical assistance to develop alternate proposals. Comments on the CDBG program or proposed project(s) will be received at this time. The hearing is being conducted pursuant to Section 570.486, Subpart I of the CFR and in compliance with the requirements of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended.
