Sealed bids for the Terminal Apron Rehabilitation will be received at the office of the Columbia County Engineering Department, 178 Route 23B, PO Box 324, Hudson, New York 12534 until **11:00 AM., local time, Friday, March 3, 2023** and there, at said office, at said time, publicly opened and read aloud. Bids shall be submitted in a sealed envelope clearly marked "**Terminal Apron Rehabilitation**". Each bid shall be submitted with the original and a duplicate copy of the entire Bid Section for this project.

This project generally includes the rehabilitation of approximately 40,000 SF of the existing Terminal Apron pavement. Work includes milling and overlay of the existing pavement and pavement marking application. The project will be bid as a Base Bid only. Prevailing wage rates apply. Contractors must be bonded and insured to the level indicated in the Contract Documents. A Federal DBE participation goal is included in the Contract. The project is sales tax exempt.

A complete set of Bid Documents, consisting of the General Provisions, Special Provisions, Technical Specifications, Bid, Agreement and Contract Drawings, will be available on **Friday, February 10, 2023** and may be obtained only from **Passero Associates at www.passero.com under the 'BID' tab** for a fee of **\$25.00 (Non-refundable)**.

A non-mandatory pre-bid meeting will be held at the Columbia County Airport on Friday, February 17, 2023 at 11:00 A.M.
