The Columbia County Department of Public Works has announced a public informational meeting will be held to discuss the proposed Culvert Replacement of Columbia County Route 21 over Tributary to Agawamuck Creek in the town of Hillsdale. The meeting will be held at the Hillsdale Town Hall located at 2609 State Route 23 / Main street, Hillsdale NY, on June 28, 2018 at 6:30 P.M.

The County, in cooperation with the County's consulting engineer, Greenman-Pedersen Inc., the New York State Department of Transportation, and the Federal Highway Administration, is developing design alternatives for the replacement of the County Route 21 Culvert. The project proposes to replace the structurally deficient culvert with a new structure that will provide a minimum service life of 75 years using the most safe and economical methods; and blend with character of the surrounding community.

The purpose of the meeting is to obtain comments on the proposed project from individuals, groups, officials, and local agencies. The County is specifically soliciting comments on the development of alternatives for the project and comments on the project's social, economic and environmental effects. This public informational meeting is part of the continuing efforts by Columbia County, the New York State Department of Transportation, and the Federal Highway Administration to encourage public input into the development of transportation projects.
