Contractors working for the Columbia County Department of Public Works will begin the construction work for the replacement of a small bridge, carrying Columbia County Rte. 21 over a tributary to the Agawamuck Creek in the Town of Hillsdale, located immediately east of Pheasant Lane, on Monday June 15, 2020.

Columbia County Rte. 21 will close at the bridge site just prior to the start of the bridge replacement work and County Rte. 21 traffic will be directed to use a temporary, off-site detour that will be signed/posted by the County's project contractors. The bridge replacement work at the County Rte. 21 bridge is expected to take approximately 4-5 months to complete.

The projects off-site detour will traverse sections of County Rte. 21, NYS Rte 22, NYS Rte. 203 and County Rte. 7 in the Towns of Hillsdale and Austerlitz.
