Notice of Public Hearing

Columbia County

Columbia County will hold a public hearing on Wednesday, September 14, 2022 at 7:00pm in person at the Columbia County Board of Supervisor's Chambers, located at 401 State Street, Hudson, New York. for the purpose of hearing public comments on the Columbia County's current Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Project #267ED915-18: 2018 Columbia County Hudson Valley Creamery Goat Dairy Conversion Project, funding amount \$375,000, amount disbursed \$45,000. The CDBG program is administered by the New York State Office of Community Renewal (OCR), and provides resources to eligible local governments for housing, economic development, public facilities, public infrastructure, and planning activities, with the principal purpose of benefitting low/moderate income persons. The hearing will provide further information about the CDBG project. Comments related to the effectiveness of administration of the CDBG project will also be received at this time. The hearing is being conducted pursuant to Section 570.486, Subpart I of the CFR and in compliance with the requirements of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended.
