FIRE AND LIFE SAFETY EDUCATOR PROGRAM

This engaging course is designed for professionals who will coordinate and deliver fire and/or life safety education to the public. It is based on *NFPA 1035: Standard on Fire and Life Safety Educator, Public Information Officer, Youth Firesetter Intervention Specialist and Youth Firesetter Program Manager Professional Qualifications* and may lead to national certification. Students will explore topics such as: Community Risk Reduction; historical fire case studies; human behavior during emergencies; basic fire behavior and protection; injury prevention; presentation strategies; age group characteristics; community resources and partnerships; selecting appropriate course materials; working with the media; course administration; and evaluation methods.

This 32-hour class will be held 2/7/22-2/11/22 (Mon 1300-1700, Tue-Thu 0800-1700, Fri 0800-1200hrs) at the Dutchess County Fire Academy at 392 Creek Rd, Poughkeepsie, NY 12601.
